Coleman WMA is a small wildlife management area to the south of Morris. It is most easily accessible from County Road 59 on the west side of the WMA. Much of the WMA is restored prairie surrounding the Coleman Slough. Visitors can expect dry ground except close to the slough, prairie potholes and the wetlands. No parking area exists so visitors will need to park along the road in the ditch.



Features of interest:

- Restored prairie
- Coleman Slough
- Two large unnamed prairie potholes
- Many other small wetlands
- Trees along NE edge
